

**RESOLUTION**  
**R 268 - 09/10**

*Acceptance of Bid for  
Milling and Resurfacing of J.L. Chestnut Boulevard (Lapsley Street to King Street)*

(Central Alabama Asphalt & Construction Company, L.L.C.)

**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma, Alabama (*the "City"*) is the recipient of a FY 2009 CDBG-R ADECA Stimulus Grant in the amount of \$500,000.00 for the Reconstruction of J.L. Chestnut Boulevard; *and*

**WHEREAS**, Paving of Chestnut Boulevard originally encompassed resurfacing from Martin Luther King Street to Lapsley Street for a total contract amount of \$358,540.00. That construction is now complete. The contract has under run for a completed cost of approximately \$339,500. The construction budget is \$413,400, therefore we have approximately \$73,900 in unobligated construction funds to extend the project; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City published legal advertisements for three consecutive weeks in the local newspaper and at least one week in a regional newspaper to receive bids for the **Milling and Resurfacing of J. L. Chestnut Boulevard (LAPSLEY TO KING ST.)**; *and*

**WHEREAS**, sealed bids were received by the City of Selma at Selma City Hall, 222 Broad Street, Selma from the time solicited and closed at 9:00am on August 26, 2010, at which time the bids received were publicly opened and read aloud; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the appropriate officials of the City of Selma and the professional engineering firm, Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood, Inc. tabulated the bids and determined Central Alabama Asphalt & Construction Company, L.L.C. to be the lowest responsible bidder, and said bids have been certified by Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood, Inc.; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to award Central Alabama Asphalt & Construction Company, L.L.C. the Contract in the amount of \$71,039.25 for **Milling and Resurfacing of J. L. Chestnut Boulevard (LAPSLEY TO KING ST.)**.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** said contract expenses shall be reimbursed from the FY 2009 CDBG-R ADECA Stimulus Grant.
